We invite: all public and independent cultural institutions from Bochum, the Ruhr region and North Rhine-Westphalia, artists of all disciplines, engaged local councils, supporters and activists. And especially newcomers.

In three workshops we want to discuss actual realities in different fields and thus address needs to develop sustainable perspectives for intercultural cooperations in the arts and culture in our region.
